Isabel Adams Coburn

Isabel Adams Coburn was a well-known, highly respected educator who resided at Keswick Ridge, and who touched the lives of many students in both the public schools and the New Brunswick Teachers' College. She was also active in the community, the church and her *alma mater*, the University of New Brunswick, serving for a time as a member of its Board of Governors.

What are the Isabel Adams Coburn Memorial Scholarships?

The scholarships have been established to honour the memory of Isabel Adams Coburn. Each year the Isabel Adams Coburn Scholarship Trust will award two or more normally non-renewable scholarships with a value up to \$2,000 each to students residing in the Keswick Ridge / Mactaquac area of New Brunswick. Who is eligible?

The scholarships will be awarded to:

Students who reside in or are from the Keswick Ridge / Mactaquac area of New Brunswick as described in this brochure (see map) and who are entering or attending the University of New Brunswick as candidates for an undergraduate or graduate degree. A balance of academic achievement, participation in extra-curricular activities and financial need will be taken into account in selecting recipients of these scholarships.

What is the area of residence for eligibility?

The geographic area of the Keswick Ridge Local Service District of New Brunswick, as comprised as at the year 2000;

The area situate in the Parishes of Bright and Queensbury, York County, New Brunswick, bounded as follows:

Beginning at the marina on the Mactaquac Causeway, and proceeding Southerly and then Westerly along the shoreline of the Mactaquac Headpond to the point where the said shoreline is intersected by the extension Southeasterly of the Scotch Lake Road; thence Northerly along the Scotch Lake Road to an intersection and then Westerly along another road as shown on the map in Schedule "A" hereto to the South Branch of the Mactaquac Stream; thence down along the said stream Easterly to the Mactaquac Arm; thence down along the Southwesterly shoreline of the Mactaguac Arm to the place of beginning, and including all residence properties fronting on either side of the highways mentioned above.

- a statement of your career goals
- a transcript of grades for course work/ programs completed
- a description of your extra-curricular activities
- a statement concerning financial need
- the name, address and phone number of at least one reference

When do I receive the scholarship?

You will be informed as soon as possible after a decision has been made. The funds will be paid to the University after the recipient has successfully completed his or her first term and has registered for the second term of the academic year.
