



The Marianne Limpert Scholarship

The Marianne Limpert Scholarship was established following Marianne Limpert's silver medal swim at the Atlantic Olympics and was awarded for the first time in 1998.

It is awarded to a competitive swimmer entering their first year of Post Secondary Education.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Competitive swimmers graduating from École Sainte Anne, Oromocto High School, Fredericton High School and Leo Hayes High School.

CRITERIA:

Applicant must

- Be pursuing post-secondary studies as well as continuing to swim competitively.
- Have attained one or more National Qualifying times in the current swim year.
- Have attained an average of 80% in their graduating year.

- Provide transcript of high school marks
- Provide proof of acceptance at a post-secondary institution
- Provide proof of acceptance on a varsity swim team
- Submit application no later than May 28th

The scholarship funds will be forwarded directly to the successful applicant for payment to the Post Secondary Institution. Cheques will be issued at the beginning of the second term following receipt of proof of passing grades and proof of having competed on the varsity swim team.
