APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Robert was only 51 when he died from brain cancer in 2019. He loved life and was passionate about giving back to his community, whether volunteering on boards, teaching fitness classes, coaching youth soccer or teaching cross-country skiing. He built numerous life-long friendships, always putting others at ease and leaving them with a kind word and a smile. Family, friends, and organizations established this scholarship to inspire others to give back to their community and pursue their dreams.

Available Scholarships:

Two \$1,000 scholarships are awarded annually to varsity high school soccer players in their graduating year, attending one of the four local area high schools: École Sainte-Anne (ESA), Fredericton High School (FHS), Leo Hayes High School (LHHS) and Oromocto High School (OHS). Students must be in grade 12 and be accepted to a publicly funded post-secondary institution.

Guidelines and Selection Criteria:

Scholarship applicants must demonstrate a record of volunteering at their school and/or community in non-school-sponsored activities.

The Fredericton Community Foundation will require a certificate of enrollment upon acceptance of the scholarship, along with your Social Insurance Number and mailing address for income tax purposes.

Applicants will be required to submit the following:

- 1. A 250-500 word written essay.
- 2. A letter of acceptance from a public post-secondary institution.
- 3. A letter of reference from either your soccer coach, athletic director or community mentor.

The application deadline is the end of day on the last Friday in April of the current year, to be received by the Fredericton Community Foundation by email at info@fredfdn.ca. Please indicate the "Robert Morimanno Memorial Scholarship Application" in the subject line.
